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RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The name of the project is "LIONS YOUTH & COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES FUND."
- 2. Only Lions clubs may participate by contribution of \$10.00 per member (all classifications), with membership based on total reported to Lions International as of the last MMR filed or the month participating in the LYCA Raffle.
- 3. Each participating Club will be issued four (4) books per club member. Each book contains ten (10) tickets. Additional books of tickets may be ordered at a charge of \$2.00 per book. Books will be sold only to the participating Club and Club checks for ALL ordered books must accompany all orders.
- 4. Tickets are to be sold by Lions or their participating individuals or groups only on a voluntary basis. There will be no selling of tickets by any persons receiving re-numeration. Individual Lions members may purchase raffle tickets, however, the participating Clubs may NOT purchase raffle tickets under the Club's name.
- 5. All clubs must keep strict accounting of all tickets sold or returned to the Committee. A statement signed by the Club President or the Club LYCA Chairperson must be sent in regard to any lost or unaccounted books. Each Club agrees to abide by the final audit of the LYCA Committee.
- 6. All books and tickets sold or unsold, must be returned to the LYCA Committee no later than March 27, 2017. You are responsible for the delivery of your Club's ticket books and proceeds/funds into the hands of your LYCA Representative. You should meet this deadline so that your books will be received and the ticket stubs included in the drawing. The LYCA Chairperson reserves the right to enforce the deadline and refuse late ticket returns.
- 7. When returning tickets and books: Books need to be organized numerically. On the partially sold book, the amount of <u>TICKETS SOLD SHOULD BE MARKED ON THE OUTSIDE COVER OF THE BOOK</u>. Books should be listed numerically on the remittance sheet provided with book number and amount of money for that book. A CLUB CHECK for the total amount must accompany this statement. Please keep a copy for your records.
- 8. DO NOT REMOVE TICKET BOOK COVERS OR CUT OR SEPARATE THE TICKETS FROM THE STUBS!
- 9. All books sold, partially sold or fully unsold must be returned WITH COVERS INTACT (DO NOT SEPARATE OR MUTILATE COVERS FROM STUBS) accompanied by the Club's check. PERSONAL CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED. Payment shall be made in full at the rate of \$9.00 for each book sold, and \$1.00 for each ticket sold from a partially sold book. STUBS THAT DO NOT SHOW NAME AND FULL ADDRESS WITH ZIP CODE OR PHONE NUMBER WITH AREA CODE MAY BE DISQUALIFIED. There are no refunds for unsold tickets or books.
- 10. ABSOLUTELY NO STUBS WILL BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE DRAWING.
- 11. The ticket drawing will be held on Friday, April 14, 2017 at approx. 8:00 pm, at the William E. Walker Recreation Center, 650 Shell Blvd., Foster City, CA. Prizes will be distributed to the ticket-sponsored Clubs for distribution to the winners within two weeks of the raffle drawing, with the exception of delivery of the Grand Prize.
- 12. The funds received from the sales of the tickets books sold to participating Clubs are used to pay for the printing of the tickets books, posters, letters and notices to the Clubs, postage, other administration costs and up to 50 prizes that are awarded after the Drawing. The net proceeds are then allocated to the District (50%) for advance funding of the campaign (if needed). The balance is shared equally with the San Francisco and Peninsula Coordinating Councils.

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
