## Barbershop Quartet Friday 12:30



- 4 acapella participants
- Performance shall be a maximum of 5 minutes not including 5 minutes for set up and 2 minutes for teardown. Set up must be completed before the performance clock starts.

## Amateur Show Friday 9:00



- Minimum of 3 participants
- Performance shall be a maximum of 10 minutes not including 5 minutes for set up and 2 minutes for teardown. Set up must be completed before the performance clock starts.



All first place wining clubs will also win this box wine set in each contest.

Performances will be judged by Convention Visiting Dignitaries with scoring:

- 1 to 25 points for originality and creativity of costumes
- 1 to 25 points for stage presence and performance
- 1 to 25 points for entertainment
- 1 to 25 points for relevance to Convention Theme  
" Together We Serve"

## Costume Parade Friday 3:00



- Participants will follow a marked parade route in a continuous circuit for a maximum of 2 minutes. Stopping along the route for an integral demonstration is permitted for 1 minute.
- Following the Final Participating Group's parade, all participants may parade around the route without stopping or musical accompaniment for a final viewing.

## Tail Twister Saturday 9:30



- Minimum of 3 participants
- Performance shall be a maximum of 10 minutes not including 5 minutes for set up and 2 minutes for teardown. Set up must be completed before the performance clock starts.
- Maximum of 4 "fine" collectors for 2 minutes.
- Additional 1 point per judge for each \$1.00 raised.
