

Communication is <u>KEY!</u> When a disaster occurs in your area, mobilize your and neighboring clubs to assist, notify your Lions Chain of Command, Zone, Region, VDG, District Governor so the District Disaster Preparedness committee can respond to assist.

 - * Red Cross, S.M. Co. Office of Emergency Services, Local Partners.

- Support the efforts of the disaster preparedness committee.
 - Training Classes, Record Keeping, Budget Support if needed.
- ❖ Insure that the district officers are aware of and support the program.
 - ❖ VDG's, Region, Zone Chairs
- ***** Coordinate district response to any disaster occurring in the district.
 - Consider aid and response to neighboring districts.
- Support the committee in responding to disasters, media relations, utilize the VDG's and impacted region & zone chairs.

Vice District Governor's

- ❖ Support the efforts of the disaster preparedness committee.
 - ❖ Act in the capacity of the District Governor in their absence.
- ❖ Assist the District Governor in supporting the efforts of the Lions impacted.
 - Utilize long –term planning to anticipate needs.
- ❖ Support the committee in interviewing clubs and lions after the event to develop a report to the District on the effectiveness of our efforts and opportunities for improvement.

Region Chairs

- Support the efforts of the disaster preparedness committee.
- ❖ Assist your Zone Chairs in identifying club resources.
 - (BBQ's, other Equipment, trained personnel)
- Assist the Disaster Chair or his designate with coordinating the efforts of the Zone Chairs, clubs and individuals responding to the disaster.
- Maintain open communication with your Zone Chairs throughout the event.
- ❖ Assist the Zone Chairs with staffing and rotation plans.
- Participate in the after-action report

Zone Chairs

- Support the efforts of the disaster preparedness committee.
- ❖ Within 90 days of your term starting, poll your club resources. (Zone Meeting)
 - (BBQ's, other Equipment, emergency trained personnel)
 - ❖ Report the information to the Disaster Chair
- ❖ Assist the Disaster Chair or his designate with coordinating the efforts of the clubs and individuals responding to the disaster.
- ❖ Maintain open communication with your clubs throughout the event.
- ❖ Assist the clubs with staffing and rotation plans.
- ❖ Participate in the after-action report

Club Team Leaders (President in absence of TL)

- ❖ Support the efforts of the disaster preparedness committee.
- ❖ Within 90 days of your term starting, poll your club resources.
 - ❖ (BBQ's, other Equipment, emergency trained personnel)
 - ❖ Report the information to the Zone Chair
- Coordinate the efforts of the club and individuals responding to the disaster.
- * Communicate with district leadership & your members throughout the event.
- ❖ Assist members with staffing and rotation plans.
- ❖ Participate in the after-action report

Examples of Club Resources that may be available during a disaster:

- **❖** Mobile Barbeques
- Trailers with tables and chairs
- Cases of water
- Food Preparation materials
- Food Dispensing materialsUtensils, plates, etc.
- Sleeping MaterialsCots, Motor Homes, etc
- First Aid Materials
- Available trained personnelCPR, First Aid, CERT, HAM Radio operators
- Untrained labor

Examples of training that may be available before a disaster:

- CPR Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation
- ❖ AED − Guardian Angel Program
- ❖ Red Cross First Aid
- Red Cross Psychological First Aid
- CERT Community Emergency Response Team
 Identify Llasons, Become a CERT Member etc.
- *Amateur Radio
 - ❖ HAMs, FRS –GMRS handheld radios.
- *Red Cross Shelter Operations
- *Red Cross Safe Food Preparation.
 - Follow Health Department Guidelines
- ***** Local Emergency Operations Center locations.

CERT Members are utilized during exercises and emergencies to assist their friends and neighbors after a disaster. The Course includes:

- Disaster Preparedness
- Fire Safety
- Disaster Medical Operations
- ❖ Light Search & Rescue Operations
- ❖ Disaster Psychology & Team Organization
- Terrorism
- ❖ A Final Exercise
