The Peninsula Council of Lions Clubs is in the process of preparing for the 50th annual Police and Fire Award Banquet. This year's event, which will recognize and honor Police Officers and Firefighters for the year 2014 will be held on Friday March 20, 2015 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Foster City. The categories' for the awards are Heroism, OR Valor and Community Service.

A change in how the awards are presented this year includes Club Presidents presenting the award and having their picture taken with the honoree from their community. Any President who is unable to attend the Banquet should arrange for a club representative to present in their absence.

Changes on the financial level of the event include, the Police and Fire Departments will pay for their own Chief and dinner guest, thus relieving clubs of that financial burden; and, unfortunately, because of higher costs, the reservation price of the event raised to \$55.00 per person and \$30.00 for children under 12.

In that nominees and one guest are guests of the PCL, as in previous years, we are asking clubs to help with that cost by paying for the Police and/or Fire Department honoree(s) that serve their community. We would also like to ask, as in previous years, that any club who doesn't have a nominee and/or has the financial ability to help other clubs with their nominees' donation. As the Police and Fire Program Book is a very nice way to recognize and congratulate the Police and Fire nominees, it is also a major source of income that also helps the PCL defray the event expenses.
