The Show of the Century

This is the first total eclipse in the continental US in 38 years and it will span 14 states, from Oregon to South Carolina. The total eclipse will only be visible along the Moon's central shadow, which is 71.5 miles wide, so most of us will only see a partial eclipse. Viewing the sun directly can cause damage to the eyes, unless you have appropriate eye protection. Various eclipse glasses are available for safe direct viewing. If you are unable to obtain authentic glasses, you can still view the eclipse indirectly. You can cast an image of the sun on a screen with a pinhole or telescope. If you intend to view the eclipse, protect your eyesight by using an approved and safe method.

The Burlingame Library will have a Solar Eclipse Viewing Party on Monday August 21, 2017 from 10:00—11:00 am. They will have glasses available for viewing the event.

The show starts around 9:00 am, with maximum (75%) coverage around 10:15 am. The spectacle will end around 11:35 am.

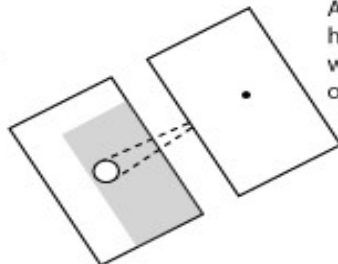

HOW TO LOOK AT THE SUN AND NOT GO BLIND

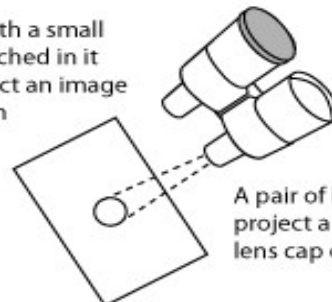
DO NOT look directly at the sun. Unfiltered sunlight will damage your eyes and could cause permanent blindness. Sunglasses will not provide sufficient protection. **ONLY** look at the sun through an approved solar filter. Even safer is to observe indirectly by projecting the sun's image with a pinhole or binoculars.

SAFE SOLAR VIEWING

- "Eclipse" glasses or welder's goggles rated 14 or higher
- Specially designed solar telescopes or solar binoculars
- Telescopes, cameras and binoculars **WITH** approved solar filters
- Pinhole projector



A card with a small hole punched in it will project an image of the sun



A pair of binoculars will also project a solar image. Leave the lens cap on the unused side.

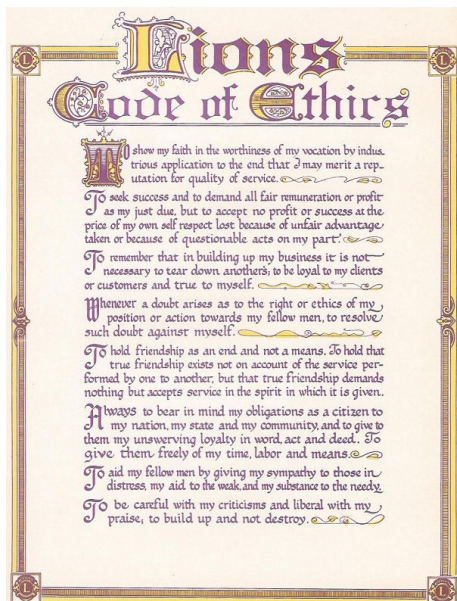

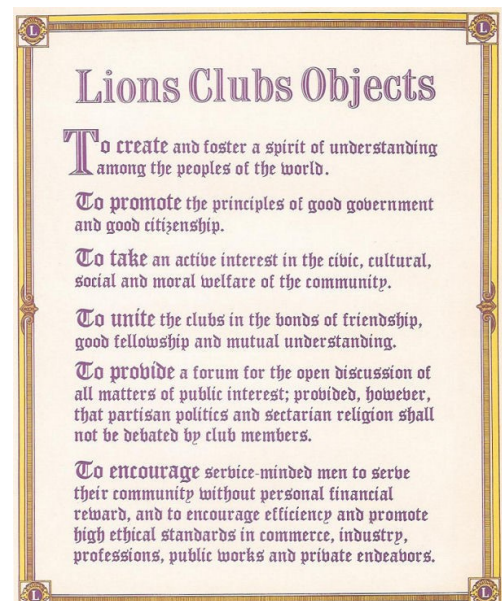
