Peninsula Council of Lions Clubs 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Police & Firefighters Awards will be presented on Friday, March 15, 2018. Daly City Host Lions Club is sponsoring nominees from Daly City Police Department and San Mateo County District Attorney's Office. The event will be held at Crowne Plaza Foster City and begins with no host cocktails at 5:30, dinner at 6:30. #### Daly City Police Department Nominee:

#### Valor Award- Officer Victor Cabatic

In the afternoon hours on Monday, September 25, 2017, Officers from the Daly City Police Department responded to the Century Theaters on the report of an unresponsive subject. Upon arrival, Officer Victor Cabatic evaluated the scene and took quick, decisive action to render aid to the victim, who was not breathing, had no pulse, and showed no signs of life. Officer Cabatic immediately began Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation and after several minutes, was able to bring the victim back to life prior to medical professionals arriving on scene. His awareness and unselfish actions clearly displayed an excellence of effort resulting in the successful resuscitation of the victim.

#### San Mateo County District Attorney's Office Nominee:

#### Service Award - Inspector David Wilson

In order to protect our elders and other financially vulnerable residents of San Mateo County, Inspector David Wilson assisted the District Attorney's Office with a resolution that was presented to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors establishing a Real Estate Fraud Prosecution Trust Fund. This newly created Unit, investigates and prosecutes any crime involving fraud, real property and recorded real estate documents as it relates to identity theft and financial elder abuse as well as increase public awareness of issues surrounding mortgage fraud. Inspector Wilson has done a tremendous job navigating the newly created position in the District Attorney's Office. Real Estate Fraud cases are document heavy and are by their very nature cumbersome and complicated. Fortunately, Inspector Wilson's extensive experience in investigations, and in the real estate field in particular, provides him with the skills necessary at affectively assess these investigations and triage the work to get the most out of his efforts. He is the only Inspector assigned to this specialized unit and this past year has investigated over 15 mortgage fraud related cases.


