



### **UPDATE ABOUT LION STEPHEN MORRIS**

Email sent by Lion Stephen Morris's family members:

Dear Family and Friends,

We are very sad to share that Steve suffered a stroke last Thursday which has left him with Global Aphasia - severe impairment to his speech and comprehension <a href="http://tactustherapy.com/global-aphasia/">http://tactustherapy.com/global-aphasia/</a>. He is unable to communicate his wants and needs and his speech is unintelligible. He is also not able to understand us when we speak to him. Over the weekend, he moved into a skilled nursing facility and he started therapy yesterday. Recovery from stroke is a long and slow process and we don't know how long it will take and how much recovery to expect.

We know how much you all care for Steve but the only things we want to ask you for are your prayers and your patience. We will update you when there is something to update, but until then, we want to ask you to please refrain from calling and asking for information or asking to visit him. At this time, a visit from you will not be helpful to his recovery, but if that changes, we will reach out to you individually. We know that you are hurting, but I'm sure you can understand that this is a very upsetting situation for us, and while we appreciate your good wishes, the many requests are becoming overwhelming.

Please don't respond to this email, we know your thoughts and prayers are with us.
