Down syndrome, also known as trisomy 21, is a genetic disorder caused by the presence of all or part of third copy of chromosome 21. It is typically, character associated with physical growth delays, characteristic facial features and mild to moderate intellectual disability. The average IQ of an adult with Down syndrome is 50, equivalent to the mental ability of 8 or 9-year old but, this can vary widely.
