Robert's Rules of Order is the most widely used manual of parliamentary procedure in the United States. It governs the meetings of a diverse range of organizations including church groups, homeowners associations, school boards, and non-profits like ourselves.

The manual was first published in 1876 by US Army Officer Henry Martyn Robert, who adapted the rules and practice of Congress to the needs of non-legislative societies. The most current edition was published in 2011. The copyright to Robert's Rules of Order is owned by the Robert's Rules association.

The procedures prescribed by the book were modeled after those used in United States House of Representatives as Robert saw fit for use in ordinary societies.

We are so lucky to have this available to us. In our organization we try very hard to follow the Robert's Rules. We use this in our e-Board meetings and our General Membership meetings.
