## *Lion IPP Dave Van Wart Receives Prestigious Silver Beaver Award*



On Tuesday, 2/26/19, the Pacific Skyline Council (over 8,000 scouts) awarded Lion Immediate Past President David Van Wart "The Silver Beaver Award" which is the highest award a local council can bestow upon a Scouting volunteer. Lady Debbie Van Wart and Lion Cal proudly attended this prestigious award dinner.

Lion IPP Dave started his Scouting career in SSF with Cub Scout Pack 60, earning his Arrow of Light Award in 1976 (Cub Scout's version of Eagle Ranking). He re-entered Scouting in 2002 when his son became a Tiger Club in Cub Scouts Pack 272 in Fremont, CA, where he was a Den Leader for the Tigers, Wolves and Bear Dens. When they moved to Millbrae, they joined our Cub Scouts Pack 355, where Lion IPP Dave served as the Webelos Den Leader for two years.

When his son Hank bridged to our Boy Scouts Troop 355, Dave served his first year on the Parent Committee and soon became a Merit Badge Counselor and Assistant Scoutmaster. He would then serve as the Scoutmaster from 2008-2013. After his service as Scoutmaster, Lion IPP Dave served Discovery District Chairman from 2013-2016. He has served since then with the Discovery District as the Friends of Scouting Chair.

Lion IPP Dave is currently the Millbrae Lions Charter Organization Rep for both our Pack 355 and Troop 355. He is still active with our Troop, serving as the Troop Committee Chair.

Lion IPP Dave and Lion PP J. Finely Thompson are the only 2 Millbrae Lions Past Presidents who were awarded this highly coveted Silver Beaver Award. Lion PP J. Finely Thompson received his award in 1961 (Thanks to Lion Ken Fowler for letting us know this important history).

## Millbrae Lions Club "Bob Jorge" School Fingerprinting Program



450,000 Children run away each year  
300,000 Children are abducted each year by family members  
More than 58,000 children are abducted each year by non-family members  
That's more than 800,000 children in America missing each year which is about 2,200 per day  
or one child every 40 seconds.

Millbrae Lions Club has been a proud part of the Child Identification Program over the years which is a community service initiative dedicated to changing these statistics by providing parents and guardians with a tool they can use to help protect their children.

Parents are provided with a current set of their child's fingerprints and a color photo on an identification card for safe keeping. The card also provides parents space to add other important information, thereby giving them assurance they will be able to provide authorities with vital information to assist their efforts should the need occur.

This year's program includes fingerprinting and photos of kindergarteners and new students at all five (5) elementary schools in Millbrae as follows;

Voting closed at 10:00 and my vanpool was scheduled to depart at 11. Tick tick tick ... no announcement. I knew something was causing the delay. We drove off and received a text message as we passed through Davis that Lion PDG Ken had won the vote. WAHOO!

What we didn't know at that time, was that the margin was 2 votes. 223 to 221. And we didn't know that the delay was because they recounted the votes 9 times. TWO VOTE difference! **Those seven Lions who got up at the crack of dawn and drove to Sacramento, including six Millbrae Lions were CRUCIAL to the vote.**

That wasn't the end of it. There were challenges, and reviews, and a movement to nullify the result and hold a new special convention. It was a battle. But the final result is that PDG Ken Ibarra of San Bruno Lions will be the candidate nominated by Lions Multiple District 4 and move forward to an election in Milan Italy in July. I want to extend my deepest gratitude to all of you who helped make this possible. He, literally, could not have done it without you. ❤️🙏

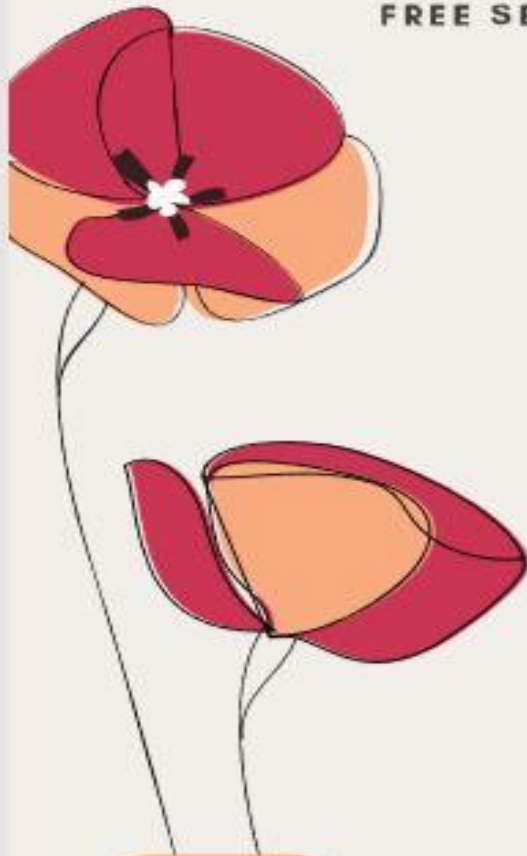
