

450,000 Children run away each year
300,000 Children are abducted each year by family members
More than 58,000 children are abducted each year by non-family members
That's more than 800,000 children in America missing each year which is about 2,200 per day
or one child every 40 seconds.

Millbrae Lions Club has been a proud part of the Child Identification Program over the years which is a community service initiative dedicated to changing these statistics by providing parents and guardians with a tool they can use to help protect their children.

Parents are provided with a current set of their child's fingerprints and a color photo on an identification card for safe keeping. The card also provides parents space to add other important information, thereby giving them assurance they will be able to provide authorities with vital information to assist their efforts should the need occur.

This year's program includes fingerprinting and photos of kindergarteners and new students at all five (5) elementary schools in Millbrae as follows;

Tuesday, March 12, 2019	8:30am	Green Hills Elementary
Monday, March 18, 2019	10:00am	Lomita Park School
Thursday, March 21, 2019	8:30am	St. Dunstan's School

Some of the tasks in the program include, writing children's names on fingerprint cards & folders, fingerprinting the children, cleaning the hands of the children, photographing the children and directing the children to each station.
