## President's Message

Hello Fellow Lions!

As always, I want to thank each of you for your support this year. In particular during this pandemic – you have been steadfast in your commitment to supporting our community needs...even when it is tough and somewhat risky to us personally. Time and again, the Millbrae Lions rise to the challenge and do our level-best to SERVE. I am so glad that our club members and their extended loved ones have, by in large have stayed safe and well during the pandemic. I wish for you all continued safety and wellness.

So as many of you have noticed, our club transitioned to Zoom meetings to conduct important club business....and keep our important personal connections with one another. We have been averaging over 25 members in a general meeting – and I would love to see more of you. Please check your email for the Zoom line from our Lions Gmail account – contains important log-in information. If you have issues or don't see the email, please let Secretary Henderson know soonest. I have only a couple meetings left as your President and I anticipate those meetings will occur via Zoom. Look forward to seeing you!

The Millbrae Lions have continued to serve and have some fun together performing service to our community during the pandemic. Recently, we have been able to secure a large food/water donation for the community. 10 Lions responded to my emergent and urgent call for Lion Sweat Equity. They showed up ready to unload from one warehouse – take it to Second Harvest Food Bank – and unload it there. As they worked – wearing masks and respecting social distance – jokes and laughs were shared...it was good to see one another face to masked face! These Lions worked with incredible efficiency and in a little over four hours, loaded and delivered more than 11,000 pounds of food and water (9 pallets) to Second Harvest. As we made the delivery, we also got to experience a moment of genuine happiness as a family arrived to get supplies and was completely thrilled to see the water donation (Second Harvest warehouse was out of water bottles). I left that day so proud of our club and our commitment to service.

We have responded to PPE requests from all across the community, donating more than 12,000 masks to first responders, members of our community and club. Recently the Lions filled an ad hoc donation request from the Millbrae Education Fund for MESD students participating in the free food program. The kids needed masks to be able to get the food from the MESD site – once again, Lions rose to the occasion and provided another 350 masks in support. The MEF/MESD and Mills PTO truly appreciates the money and supplies given by our club to help those in need. I thank all of you for making that possible.

Speaking of need, you are likely aware of the Hemlock Ave fire that displaced more than 50 Millbrae residents. The Board of Directors approved a project and funding to enable our Club to join City, Red Cross, and Central County Fire efforts to help these displaced families that lost nearly everything in the fire. Our funds, plus a generous donation from a community member and another non-profit connected with the Lions provided much needed food, clothing, money and supplies. We continue to monitor the situation on a weekly basis thru the City and look for ways to help as appropriate. I thank the Project Team that rallied on short notice to lead our efforts.

I do want to take a moment in my message to share that I am deeply saddened – and angered – over the unjustified and unnecessary death of George Floyd at the hands of Minneapolis police. I am not OK at all with what I saw on that video. Treatment of another person like this - It was wrong – period. His death has sparked outrage and protests all across our country, to include our local communities here in the Bay Area. I don't support the looting at all – I do understand the protests. As a human being, we all deserve to be treated better than that. I pray for change, understanding, and compassion. Thank you for allowing me to share that with you.

As I look ahead, I don't have an answer for you on the upcoming 2020/2021 BOD installation. More on that as we see what is really possible (and permitted) by the County/City/GHCC. In talking with Lion Anthony about Millbrae Machines, he said we are still planning to have the car show but it might be later in September/October. As of now, the Lions Golf Tournament is on track for our 2nd consecutive tournament at GHCC on September 14th. If you haven't registered, please go to our website and register ASAP!

Hopefully, you are reading this message and taking great pride in being a Millbrae Lion. We serve because we care about one another and our community. We are not motivated by personal accolades or interests – Lions authentically serve from the heart with a health dose of MLC Mojo!

I miss seeing you all in person and I do look forward to that opportunity again...hopefully real soon.

## Second Harvest Food Bank - MLC Sweat

The 75 members (amazing Millbrae Volunteers) of the Millbrae Lions Club continues to be grateful to have the ability and drive to help those in need in both Millbrae and San Mateo County; especially during these difficult times. The past 3 weeks we addressed several important needs:









1. FOOD & WATER/DRINKS - Today, 5/29/20, 10 Millbrae Lions packaged and delivered 9 pallets (over 11,000 lbs) of dry food and water/drinks to the SECOND HARVEST FOOD BANK in San Mateo. There was a quote in a recent San Jose Mercury News Article where Second Harvest CEO Leslie Bacho - "We saw a 40% increase in need since the crises began, nothing like we've seen before".

2. FACE MASKS - The Millbrae Education Foundation President Elect Joy Pasamonte Henry requested additional face masks to provide to those Millbrae School Families who are unable to obtain on their own. Last week, Lion President Rob DuCote provided an additional 350 Face Masks. Since the pandemic crises began, our club has donated over 12,000 masks.

3. CLOTHING AND GIFT CARDS - Tragically, on 5/6/20, there was a 3 alarm apartment fire in Millbrae where close to 50 residents were displaced and lost most of their valuables. We helped provide clothing via John's Closet (a nonprofit in the memory of John Papan). In addition, thanks to a generous donor and funding from the Millbrae Lions Club, we provided several thousands of \$s gift cards from both Target and Visa.
