We are grateful for your belief, trust and confidence that your Millbrae Lions Club (close to 80 Millbrae Volunteers) can help nurture your upcoming important community events.

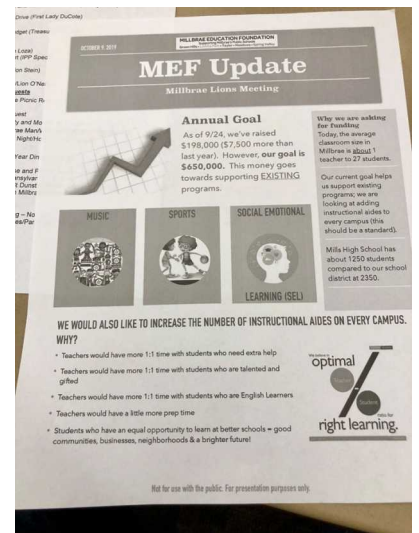
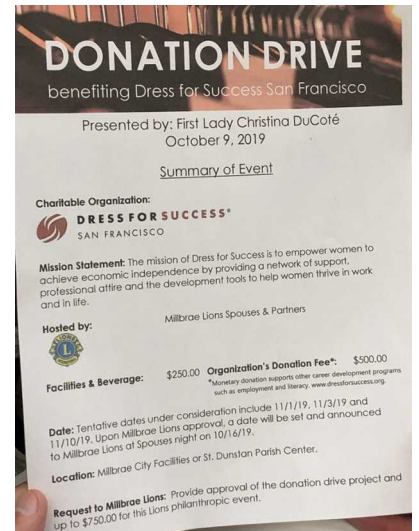
