PVLC Service Project - Move-In Kits

Our club has an ongoing project where we put together Move-In Baskets to assist our veterans as they complete various programs at the Menlo Park and Palo Alto VA facilities and are transitioning back into the 'real world'.

The Move-In Kits consist of a laundry basket filled with the basic essentials needed for 2 people; cooking pans, utensils, cleaning supplies (dishwashing soap, cleansers, sponges, mop & broom), place setting and silverware. The majority of veterans do not have the resources to purchase the essentials when they first move into their new home. We occasionally receive donations of blankets and other household items, which are added to the basic kits. In certain situations, those moving into housing where a bed is not currently in place, the Lions Club will include an air mattress. Donations of basic furniture are always welcome.

The purpose of these kits is to help Veterans re-establish basic living skills. The kit enables the recipient to prepare a simple meal and thus encourages healthier eating habits. A setting for 2, promotes socialization skills, which creates a more homelike environment. The cleaning supplies enable the recipient to maintain a clean house, promoting a healthier living environment.
