
Sending well wishes that everyone is Sheltered in Place and Staying Safe and Healthy!



- * To Take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.

- * To Provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.
- * To Encourage service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.

Lions Clubs Code of Ethics

- * To Show my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.
