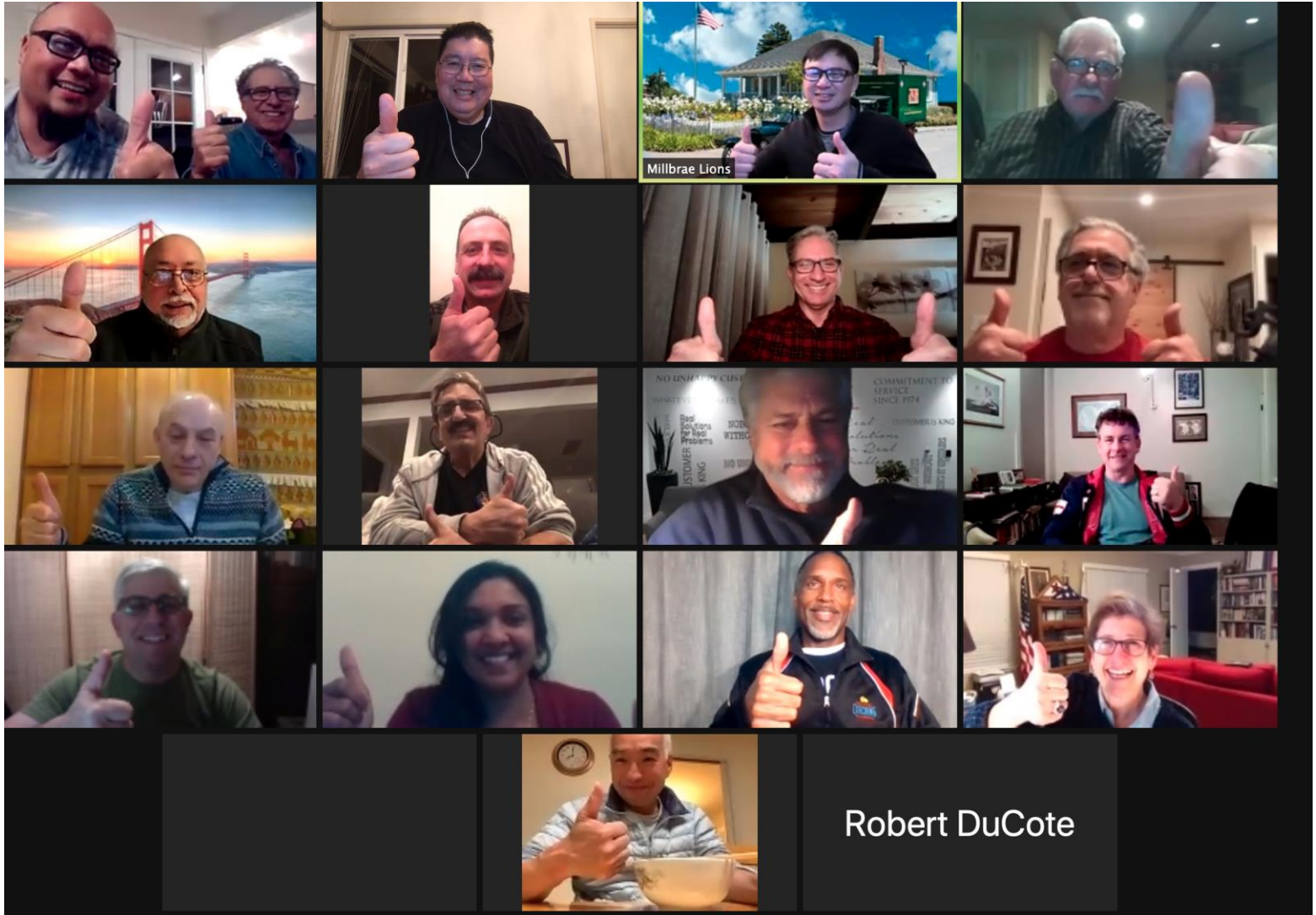

Millbrae Leo's Activities - A New Park Bench for Millbrae!

Our Millbrae Leo's group has been meeting regularly (online!) and is continuing their endeavors to make a positive difference in our community - by volunteerism and activism!

At the beginning of February the Leo's kicked off their latest project - the beautification of Millbrae, which has two great components: Reducing the amount of plastic (stretch/film) from our landfills AND turning that recovered plastic into a Park Bench that will be installed along the Millbrae Spur Trail.

The Leo's are handling the project management, the advertising campaign (producing video tutorials, messaging, digital promotion), and the process (gathering/sorting/screening/delivering/tracking materials and coordinating with the project sponsor, Trex). They have also coordinated with the City of Millbrae Department of Public Works to arrange for a professional installation. It's an excellent real-life, working model of how to be effective and successful in community involvement that they will be able to put to good use on their paths to becoming adult Global Stewards/Citizens!

Producing a resin-based, plastic recycled Park Bench requires collecting 500 lbs. of clean, dry, stretch film plastic (recycling #2, #4 symbols). Their goal is 100 lbs./month, and they will be arranging for pickup/drop-off about every 2 weeks. For reference, a grocery produce bag (stretch plastic) holds about 1 pound of usable plastic (newspaper bags, produce bags, bubble wrap, etc...) when rolled into small cylinders (see accompanying image). PLEASE save your 'stretchy plastic' and let the Leo's know when you would like them to pick it up, or when you can drop it off. Millbrae Leo's Activities - A New Park Bench for Millbrae!

1 How does the challenge work?

Determine a six-month collection time period.

Collect a minimum of 500 lbs. or 40,500 plastic film and bags.

Weigh and record amount of film recycled each month.

Deliver the collected plastic film to a participating retailer (see list) for recycling.

What can be recycled?

All plastic must be clean, dry and free of food residue.



If completed, the 4 ft bench would be placed at our community's very own Spur Trail.

LIONS CODE OF ETHICS:
