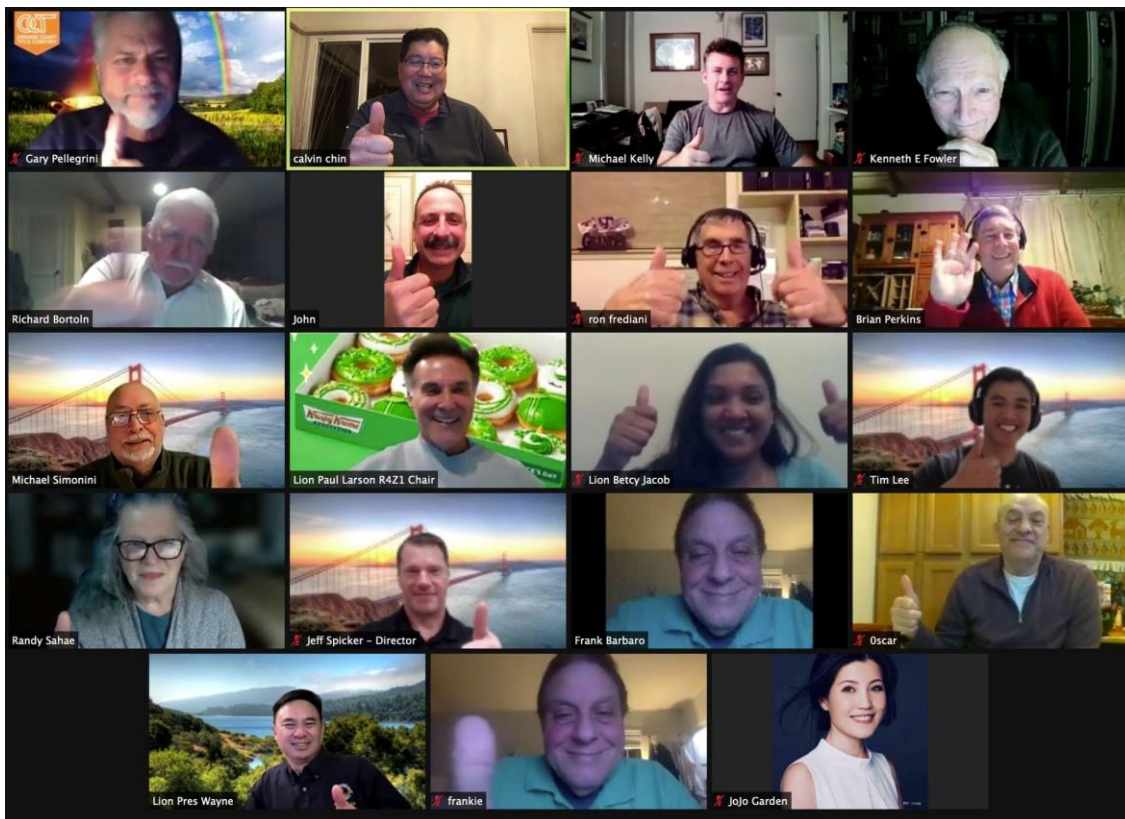
Afterwards, we discussed about our upcoming projects:

REMEMBERING EIGHT YEARS AGO MARCH 2013

Remembering Eight Years Ago March 2013:

The Millbrae Community Youth Center project was almost complete. Four+ years of effort culminated in a sparkling ADA compliant, earthquake reinforced location for the youth of our community. The Millbrae Lions negotiated the three way agreement, and took responsibility for the construction and upgrades. Denis Fama headed up the fundraising efforts but the entire community rallied around this project, with major donations from the Millbrae Lions, Millbrae Rotary, Millbrae Community Foundation, Peninsula Chinese Business Association, the Millbrae Elementary School District and the City of Millbrae. Multiple community work days were very well attended and hands on help came from over a hundred volunteers including of course, our Lions, plus the Millbrae Leos, Rebuilding Together Peninsula, Central Peninsula Church, Boy Scout Pack 355, and Doug Rider the Millbrae City Building Inspector who not only helped us meet all code requirements he also rolled up his sleeves and installed railings, signs and placards to ensure our final project would get signed off (by him!). I have dozens more pictures, including some pictures of construction of the original Scout House. When we next get together, ask pretty much any Lion who's been a member for more than 8 years, and they'll tell you how they worked on this project!

Yes, you read that right. Benches plural! Since there is a '1 bench per 6 month project' window from Trex, our industrious Leo's have created an impressive solution to the project limitation... MENTOR OTHER MILLBRAE YOUTH GROUPS, and teach them how to run the same project! (background, our Leo's completed their 6 month task of accumulating 500+ pounds of plastic – in just 6 weeks! New bench is ordered and on the way)

The Millbrae Leo's have now successfully partnered with the Millbrae Daisy Scouts (5-6 year-olds) and the Millbrae Girl Scouts (10-11 year-olds), and the 'new' youth groups application was just approved by Trex for an immediate start! And talk about immediate – we may have set a new record... The Daisy's application was accepted by Trex on Friday, April 2nd. The VERY next day, Saturday April 3rd, the Leo's and the Daisy's (with parents in tow) met at City Hall for their first 'official' work party. Such work, and what a party. **246 pounds of plastic was sorted, bagged, weighed, and deposited** at our local Millbrae Safeway loading dock (thanks again Millbrae Safeway Management Team – Store Director **Simo Elomari!**). In just 1 day, literally ½ of their 6 month goal was met. Shout out to Troop Leaders **Susan Yao** and **Eileen Ring** – we love the partnership! The community has rallied to the cause, plastic that would have ended up in a landfill is being repurposed for park benches, and there are over 160 Millbrae Neighbors on NextDoor that have 'liked/loved/contributed' to the recycling drive so far, and it's growing! And, as importantly, the Daisy's got to spend time working with and getting to know the Millbrae Leo's – such a collaboration! The whole of Millbrae can celebrate the accomplishments of our amazing youth groups, they make us all very proud... Where do the Leo's go from here? Big plans/announcements coming – watch this space!

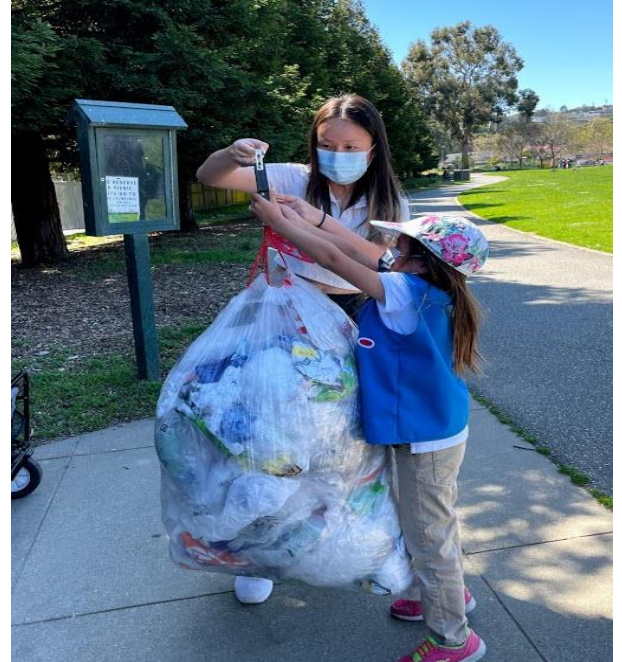

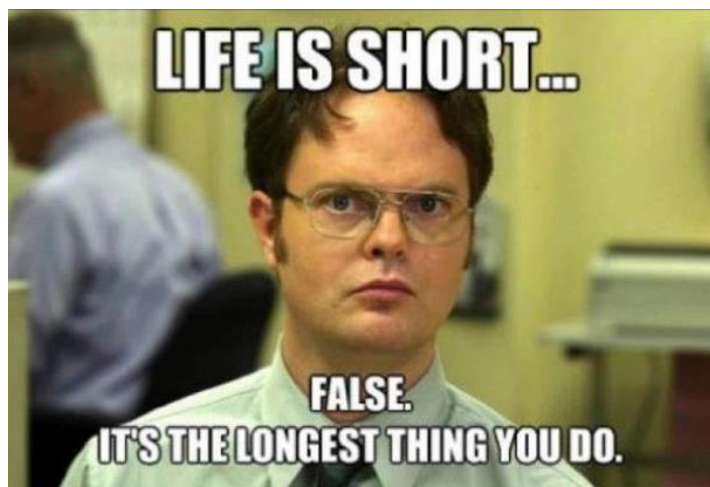

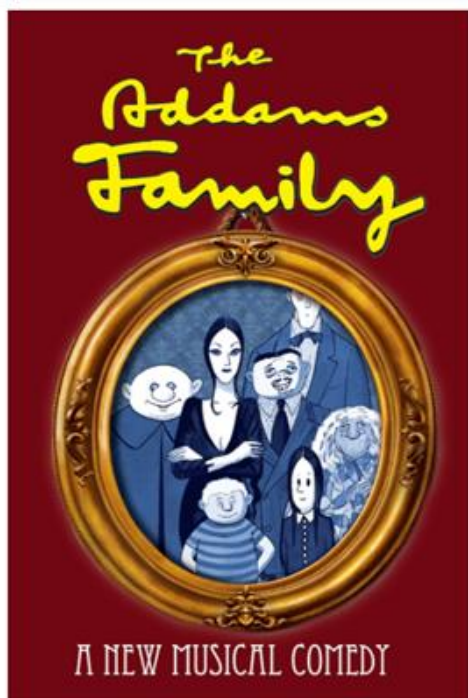
