



### Millbrae Lions Club 2020 Relay for Life Participation By Lion Bill Meyer



Many of us have been affected by cancer in one way or another. My Dad passed away from colon cancer almost 21 years ago at the young age of 65. My niece had eye cancer when she was a few months old. A colleague at work has brain cancer. Think of your own experiences and let that be your motivation to take action!

And now, COVID-19 has put cancer patients at risk – attacking already weakened immune systems, delaying cancer treatments, and closing many clinical trials. Because of the impact cancer has had on our lives, let's do something about it. We are joining Relay For Life to remember people we've lost and offer up support to anyone in our community who is affected by cancer. And that's why we need your support!

No surprise, this year the Relay for Life event will be virtual. The event date is Saturday 9/26/20. This year there are several community service groups involved as part of the Relay for Life of North Peninsula, including the Rotary, San Bruno Lions, and others.

The MLC has been involved in RFL for many years. In the past Lions Gary Pellegrini and PP Hardit Chaudhary, and others, organized and engaged the MLC to provide food service for the volunteers and participants. As I recall from being a volunteer a few times, several local restaurants donated/provided the food.

Here is specifically how we can contribute this year:

- We are forming a Fundraising Team online. Each MLC member will receive a link to our MLC Team site where you can add your donation. Every little bit helps! You can also share the link with your family and friends and ask them to donate. That way we can really generate a lot of potential contributions.
