PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Dear Millbrae Lions, Family, & Friends,

We hope you and your family are well. As part of the Millbrae Lions family, please do not hesitate to me if you have a concern or request assistance.

Winter has arrived, and so has the next wave of COVID19 infections. San Mateo County is more likely to move to a more restrictive COVID19 category. That means less congregation, smaller gatherings, and the closing of some businesses like gyms and bars.

Because of the increase of COVID19 cases and the membership's safety, we decided against any Lion in-person meetings until further notice. Dr. Fauci indicated that a vaccine may be available to everyone by April 2021. So hopefully, we can plan to meet in May 2021.

Meanwhile, we will continue to support the Lion/Millbrae Drive-In movies and other community activities that do not involve gatherings but includes social distancing.

Speaking of the free community Drive-In movies, they continue to be a success. The City has footed most of the cost of staff and set up. Hence the MLC Board decided to donate the proceeds from the movies back to the City of Millbrae.

Many of you know that MLC has been in negotiations with the Millbrae Baseball Corporation (MBC) to ratify an agreement for the safe and effective operations of the Millbrae Lions Baseball program (LBP). The agreement was approved at the last MLC board meeting last Wednesday. There was a healthy and spirited discussion, but in the end, the kids of Millbrae will continue to benefit from a well ran program. Essentially, the Millbrae Lion's Baseball program will be under MLC's control, with the two top MBC officers being MLC members. The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will be reviewed annually by MLC and adjusted as needed. In essence, the LBP will be subcontracted and operated by MBC to maintain its own ledges and accounts.

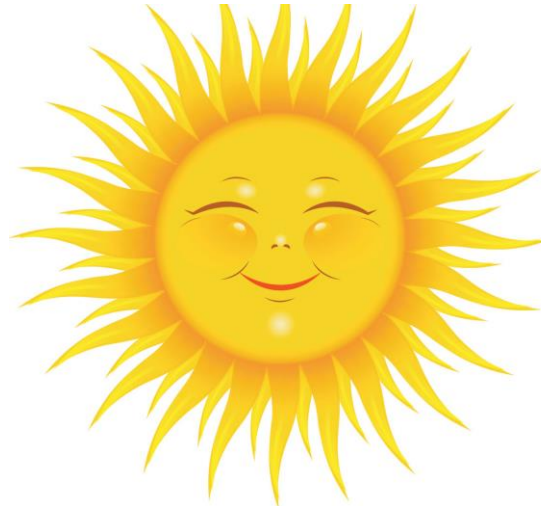

MLC City of Millbrae Veterans Day

The Millbrae Lions Club proudly organized and sponsored the first City of Millbrae Veterans Day remembrance ceremony honoring veterans. MLC held the event on November 11, 2020.

Veteran's Day is always on November 11. "The War to End All Wars," WW1, ended on the 11th minute of the 11th hour of November 11, 1918. It began as Armistice Day as proclaimed by President Woodrow Wilson as a day of remembrance. Then in 1954, President Dwight Eisenhower changed it to Veteran's Day.

Lion President presided over the ceremonies. City staff and Lion/City Manager Tom Williams set up for the event. The ceremonies began with raising the nation's flag and the familiar Missing In Action black flag by the sheriffs to the bugler's call of "To the Colors." Copy and paste this link to hear "To the Colors." <https://youtu.be/gbSxOQqiVhM>. The National Anthem followed. This is a military protocol. The veterans had the option to salute while the civilians placed their right hands over their left chest.

Lion President Wayne Lee then introduced the Mayor Millbrae, Reuben Holober, the Vice Mayor, Ann Schneider, the former Mayors, Dan Quigg, Robert Gottschalk, and San Mateo County Supervisor, Dave Pine.

Lion/City Manager and Veteran Tom Williams then described the table's significance for the Fallen Service Person. See photo. Watch the MCTV YouTube recording for an explanation and the ceremonies at this link: <https://youtu.be/2WvSI4A3P20>.

Veteran's Day and Memorial Day have a significant meaning to Lion President Wayne Lee. His father, Arnold Lee's, served 35 years in the US Army active duty and reserves.

The last and most important portion of the program entailed introducing the veterans present at the ceremony. They included Lion PP Rich Bortolin (US Army), Lion PP Dan Quigg (US Army), Lion PP John LaDuca (US Army), Lion IPP Rob DuCote (US Navy), and Lion Tom Williams (US Marines).

The successful and solemn celebration and remembrance set the stage for future MLC hosted Veteran's Day.

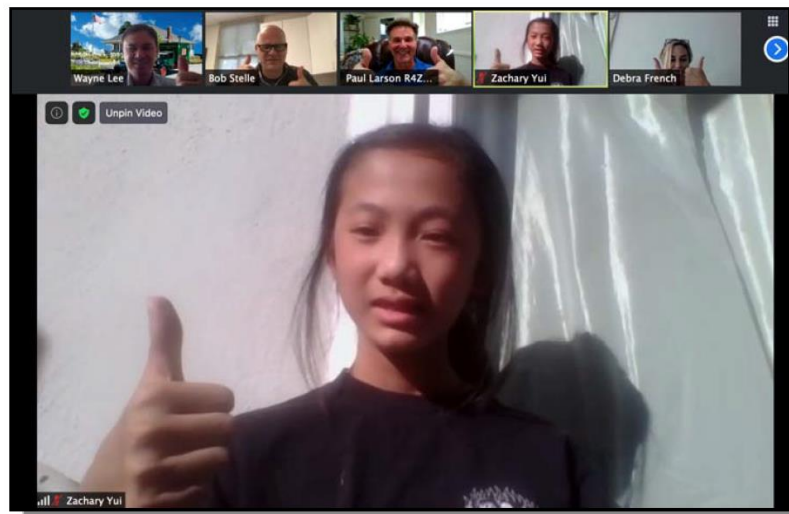

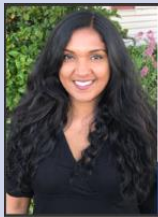
