Fellow Lions - As you all know by now California has formally retired the tier system and has aligned its policies with the Centers for Disease Control - <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/fully-vaccinated.html>.

With that said, I cannot tell you all how excited I am that we can all ditch our face masks. However, if you have not received your vaccine, there are instances where a face covering is required. So, if you have not received your vaccine yet, please do so right away.

Also, there are no longer capacity or distancing requirements for most businesses and public settings; however, regardless of vaccine status everyone must still wear a face covering in the following settings:

On public transit (buses, ride-shares, taxis, airplanes, trains, ferries)

- Indoors in K-12 schools, child care, and other youth settings
- Health care settings and long-term care facilities
- Correctional facilities and detention centers
- Homeless shelters, emergency shelters, cooling centers

Some businesses, public agencies, and other organizations may still require face coverings, for both employees and members of the public, therefore it may be good to keep a mask handy, just in case for a little while longer.

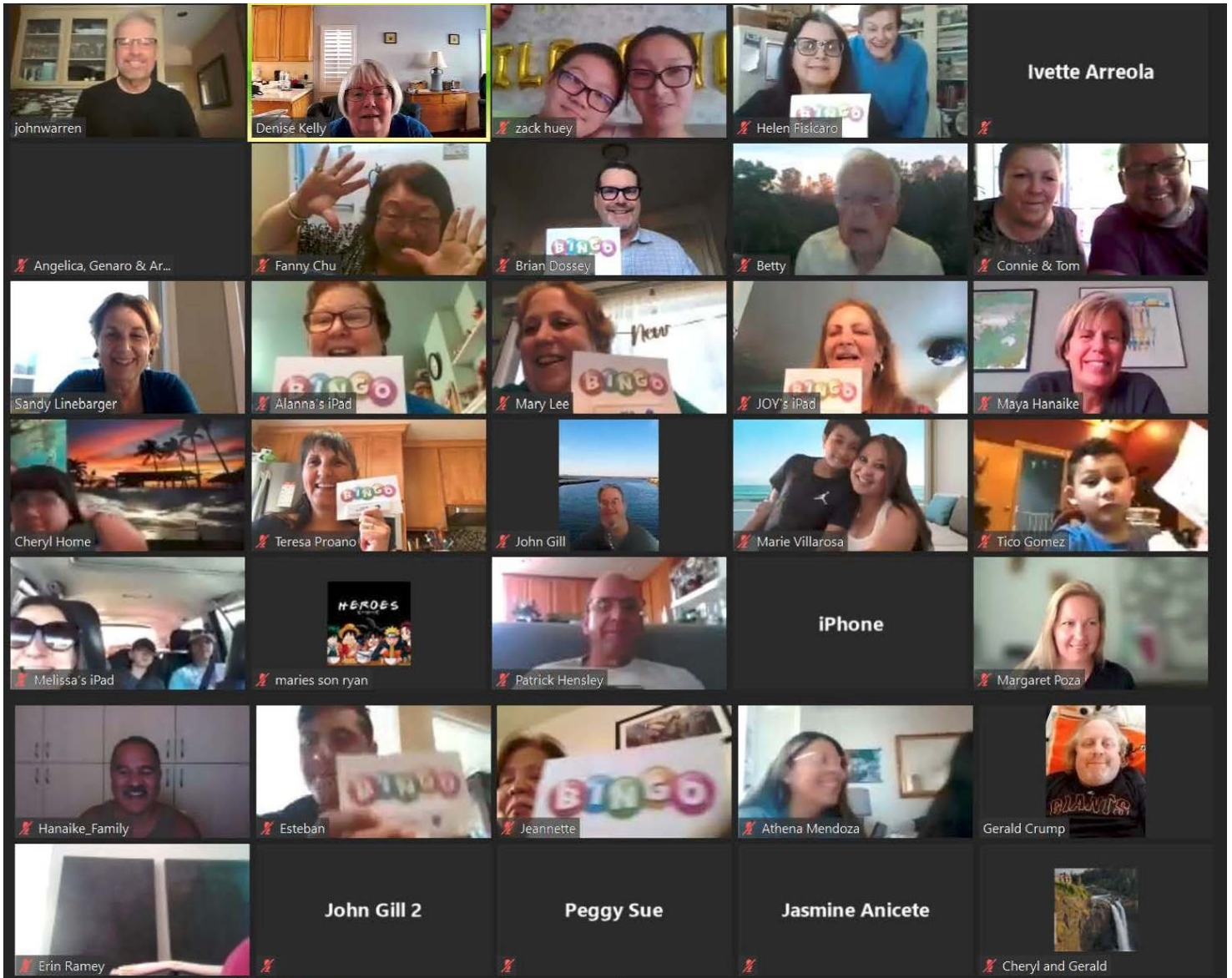

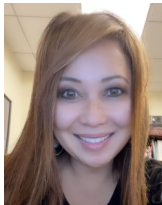

Don Riker Recycling Fund—Bring your cans and bottles to the second meeting each month or contact Lion Ed Dollard to arrange pick up. Turn in at your local recycling center and donate the money to the fund.
