

Foster City Lions Club Humanitarian Aid Fundraiser for Ukraine





Humanitarian Aid Fundraiser for Ukraine Update as of May 30th 2022

"It is during our darkest moments that we must focus to see the light" by Aristotle Onassis.

Ukraine and its people woke up on February 24th 2022 to the full-scale military invasion by Russia. More than 5.5 million people have fled Ukraine in response to the Russia's invasion. Millions more are displaced within the country, making this the fastest-growing refugee crises in Europe.

Our Foster City Lions Club together with the Lion member Kateryna Davydova set up a Humanitarian Aid Fundraiser for Ukraine to respond to the humanitarian crises. Kateryna's family is in Ukraine and continues to live through the ongoing war. Collected funds to benefit the Lions Club International Foundation's (LCIF) Refugees and Displaced Persons Funds. All donations - 100% - benefit grants and programs. LCIF is awarding grants to Lions supporting Ukrainian refugees who have crossed their borders. Lions in Ukraine have also received LCIF grants to address the critical needs of people who remain in the country. Grant funding enables Lions to purchase and distribute immediate relief items, such as food, clothing, hygiene supplies, sleeping bags and medicine. As of May 2022, LCIF awarded 35 grants totaling US\$1,153,260.

Foster City Lions Club initial goal was to raise US\$15,000 by May 9th 2022, which was quickly surpassed and a new goal was set in the amount of US\$25,000. As of May 30th 2022, we have raised total of US\$30,375.

A lot of activities took place behind the scene to make this fundraiser a great success. We have developed partnerships with Compass and Ukrainian American Coordinating Council (UACC), set up an online campaign donation link and Facebook fundraiser, advertised in the local paper "Islander" and Compass offices in the Peninsula-Northern California region, approached local businesses, attended local Foster City farmer's market, and last but not least organized a live fundraiser event on May 6th 2022 with a live auction and opportunity drawing prizes. All contributions received were funneled to the Foster City Lions Club campaign to support Ukraine.

We thank everyone for all your help and support. We look forward to continuing making a difference! United we bring Ukraine closer to victory!
