# Bay Area Leos Club

- The Bay Area Leos have brought the Trex Recycling Project to their community.
  - They partnered with Burlingame City Hall, Hillsborough Town Hall, and the Burlingame Public Library to collect 500 lbs. of plastic for a park bench
  - They monitor the 3 locations, and every Saturday they collect and sort through the accumulated plastic to filter out any unrecyclable plastic
  - They began collecting on October 10th, 2021 and have been able to collect 500 lbs of plastic by December 12, 2021
  - Since then, they have continued to collect more plastic and reached over 860 lbs of plastic
  - From the Bay Area Leos Club, “This project has grabbed the community’s attention and we were given a spotlight in the Burlingame Parks and Recs Spring Magazine. We would like to thank the Millbrae Leo Club and Lion Michael Kelly for helping us get started on this project. We couldn’t have done it without your help!”
