

Lion PDG Ken Ibarra of the San Bruno Lions was originally encouraged to join Lions 30 years ago by our own Lion PP Mike Gianni, who was working with PDG Ken on a construction project.

Now, 29 years later, Lion PDG Ken stands on the threshold of becoming a Lions Clubs International Director the first in District 4-C4 since Lion Maurice Perstein was elected to serve in 1958-1960.

Lion PDG Ken has a long list of accomplishments in 4-C4, really too long to list, but his emphasis has been on programs that foster leadership potential in existing members and provide nourishment for all those who desire to serve. Working as a mentor with groups, or serving soup side by side with clubs, he always walks the walk.

In order to be considered for International Director, a Lion must not only have a long-distinguished record of service, but also be endorsed by his San Bruno Lions Club, his District 4-C4, and by California Multiple District MD-4. Millbrae Lions turned out in full force for votes at the District level and the MD-4 level, which Lion Ken won by the slimmest of margins, 223 to 221 votes, against the candidate from Southern California. NINE Millbrae Lions including our three PDGs, Habeeb, Pignati and Simonini, drove up to Sacramento and voted that morning. And then drove back. That's who we are, and that's what we do, in Millbrae.

California continues to be a leading state in Lionism with over 700 clubs and as such, has a distinguished history of International Directors. The most recent are Lion IDs Dana Biggs, 2007-09, Bob Smith 2010-12, Larry Dicus, 2013-15, and Howard Hudson 2015-17. Lion PDG Ken Ibarra follows in their footsteps to represent California, and in particular, our District 4-C4, literally, around the world. (**CONTINUED**)
