Please mark **Saturday, September 25** on your calendar and plan on joining us, especially for the in-person lunch (provided by the Millbrae & San Bruno Lions Clubs) (12 noon – 1:00 pm), the car parade from San Bruno to Burlingame (2:30 pm), and the Luminaria Ceremony (presented by the Mills HS Interact Club) online via Zoom at 9:00 pm!
