WHEREAS The award can be granted to individuals, families and organizations located throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS Depending on the amount of service hours completed, individuals can receive the Bronze, Silver, Gold, and/or the President's Call to Service Award (also referred to the President's Lifetime Achievement Award). To attain the Gold standard threshold, an individual/group must have at least 250 certified hours of community service for the service year; and

WHEREAS The Call to Service Award is the most prestigious of the President's service awards, and it has been bestowed to few Americans to recognize extraordinary and exceptional service; and
