

Our Board voted to match Lion donations up to \$1000 to help people who have been displaced by Putin's war against Ukraine. The Lions Club International Foundation (LCIF) has a standing fund where every dollar donated is sent to Lions Clubs that are directly helping displaced people. Millbrae Lions have already raised over \$2,000 dollars that will be matched by the Club so \$3,000 that will go to Lions Clubs in Poland and the other countries next to Ukraine and working to help over 4 million displaced people, predominantly women, children and elderly fleeing the war.

OR, you can give cash or check to the Millbrae Lions Club asking that this donation go to the Ukrainian Refugee and Displaced Peoples Fund. Every \$1,000 donated by the Millbrae Lions Club earns our Club a Melvin Jones Fellowship Award.


