PVLC Service Project - Kitchen Move-In Kits

Kitchen kits are for the homeless Veterans who are moving into HUD-VASH (Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing). This program provides permanent housing for eligible single homeless Veterans and Veterans with families and is partnered with the Government HUD Housing Agency.

The kitchen kits are composed of dishes, cups and silverware for 2 persons. Also included in the kits are pans and cooking utensils, kitchen and apartment cleaning supplies (dishwashing soap, cleansers, sponges, mops and brooms). The majority of veterans do not have the money to initially purchase these essential items when they move into their apartments.

The purpose of the kitchen kits are to help Veterans re-establish basic living skills. The kits enable the Veteran to prepare a simple meal and develop healthier eating habits thus are less likely to eat out of fast food containers. A setting for two promotes socialization skills and adds to a more homelike environment. The cleaning supplies assist the Veterans in maintaining a clean house thus promoting and healthy living environment.
